Pursuant to General Instruction E of Form S-8, Luminar Technologies, Inc. (the "Registrant") is filing this Registration Statement with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Commission") to register (i) 20,991,566 additional shares of Class A common stock under the Luminar Technologies, Inc. Amended and Restated 2020 Equity Incentive Plan (the "Plan") pursuant to the provisions of the Plan providing for an automatic increase in the number of shares reserved for issuance under the Plan; and (ii) an increase of 20,000,000 shares of Class A common stock to the employee share pool for potential issuance as part of the Registrant's ordinary course of business, as approved at the 2024 Annual Meeting of Stockholders on June 5, 2024. The Registrant previously registered shares of its Class A common stock for issuance under the Plan on February 26, 2021 (Registration No. 333-253658), June 22, 2022 (Registration No. 333-265752) and June 9, 2023 (Registration No. 333-272577). This Registration Statement hereby incorporates by reference the contents of the Registrant's registration statements referenced above.
